This historic legislation is available to **CriminalSource** subscribers as part of their subscription and to other WestlaweCARSWELL subscribers on a pay per view basis.

WestlaweCARSWELL was the first online product on the market to contain this information and the content is far deeper than anywhere else. Histories include not only the statutory cites for the various amendments and re-enactments, but also the wording of these changes.
