

As of April 1, 2008 **IPSource** will be the sole online legal research service incorporating the authored head notes and taxonomy featured in the print version of the *Canadian Patent Reporter* from Canada Law Book.

Reproduced in full on **IPSource** are the C.P.R. classification for each decision reported by the C.P.R. since its inception in 1942, as well as the valuable head notes and annotations authored by Glen Bloom and his associates at Osler, Hoskin & Harcourt LLP.

Users can search using the C.P.R. taxonomy within **IPSource**.

- Select the Canada Law Book cases radio button to focus on the C.P.R. only. Users can access every decision since the inception of the C.P.R. as well as newly reported decisions as they are selected.
- Select the **IPSource** radio button to also search the most comprehensive collection of reported and unreported decisions available.
- Enter the phrases or taxonomic string you wish to search. **IPSource** will use them to quickly identify cases on an issue.
