Edited by Gregory Tardi, B.A. (Hons.), B.C.L., LL.B., Senior Legal Counsel in the Office of the Law Clerk and Senior Parliamentary Counsel at the House of Commons in Ottawa, this new journal provides a forum for the growing body of interdisciplinary legal literature on the subject of "law and politics". National in scope, and comparative in perspective, the subject areas to be addressed by the Journal include:

- the law relating to Parliament as an institution;
- Parliamentary law, privilege and custom;
- legislative practice;
- the law relating to governance;
- the interactions among public law, public policy and administration and
- the influence of law in governing and its impact on the conduct of government.
