

## Tip: ICLL – Using The List Of Periodicals While Searching ICLL

The ICLL search template enables you to link to a [Table of Periodicals Indexed](#). This Table lists all periodicals indexed in ICLL and is organized by periodical abbreviation.

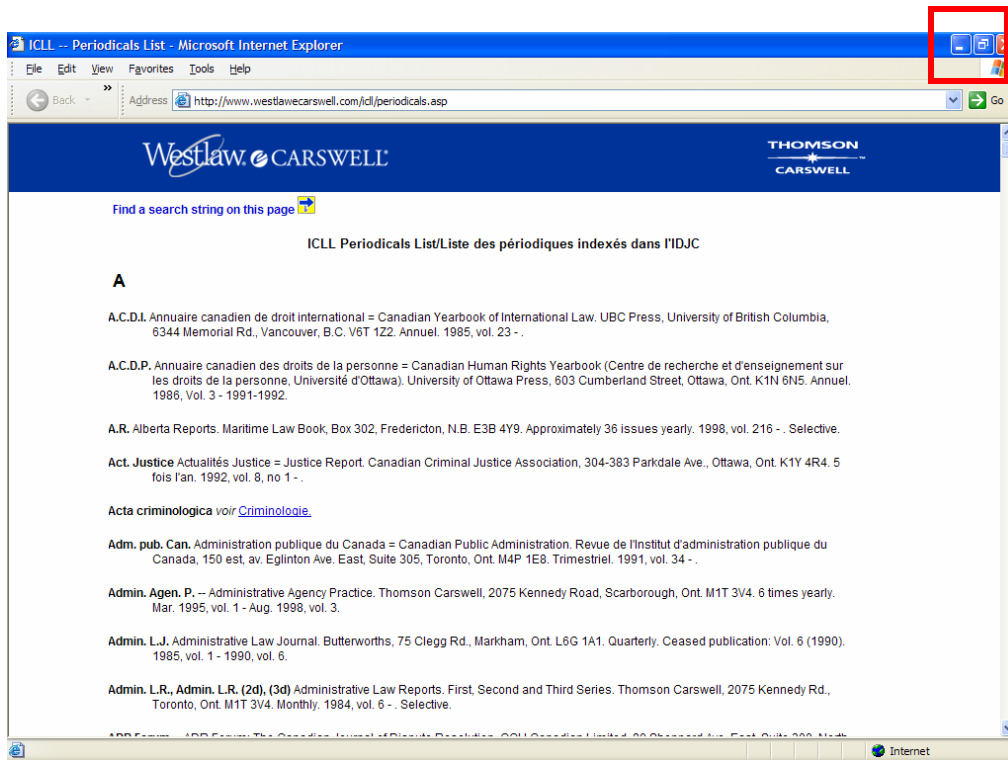

Print users of ICLL have traditionally found this table helpful in deciphering what periodicals are being referenced in ICLL entries, and would like to use this tool to understand references to periodicals when viewing entries and result lists on WestlaweCARSWELL.

Unfortunately the Table of Periodicals can only be directly opened from the ICLL template -- not when viewing search results on WestlaweCARSWELL.

If you wish to have the Table at your disposal while viewing ICLL search results, we recommend doing the following:

1. As a first step in your ICLL research, open the Table of Periodicals by linking to it from the ICLL template.
2. Minimize the Table, by clicking on the minus sign at the top right of your screen.



The Table is now open and can be accessed when needed from the task bar at the bottom of your screen:
