

Ability to Search only Tribunal, or only Court Decisions

The Case Law Custom Search Templates on all Source tabs will have an option to allow you to limit your search to retrieve court decisions only, or tribunal decisions only, if you wish.

This new drop-down menu has been added to each of the Case Law Custom Search template, in the **Limit Results (optional)** section. The default selection remains "All Canadian Decisions".
